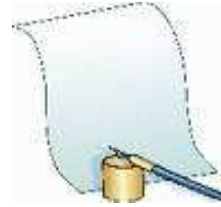


Write the Story for the Picture!



1. With a partner/s or by yourself, choose a picture that interests you.
2. Tape or glue it to the top of a piece of paper.
3. Below the picture, write a story about the picture with your partner/s. Think about what happened **before** the picture was taken and **after** the picture was taken. Your story must have *at least 5* sentences.
4. **Proofread your story using the Writing Checklist below.** If you're not sure about something, check a dictionary or ask a friend!
5. When you finish proofreading, post your story for others to read.
6. Read and enjoy the stories written by your classmates!

Writing Checklist	Put a \checkmark if it is OK:
Each paragraph begins with an indentation (space).	
Each sentence begins with a capital letter.	
Each sentence ends with a punctuation mark (period, exclamation point, or question mark).	
Words are spelled correctly.	
Grammar looks good.	
Be sure to check whether your verbs are in the right tense and agree with the subject of the sentence.
